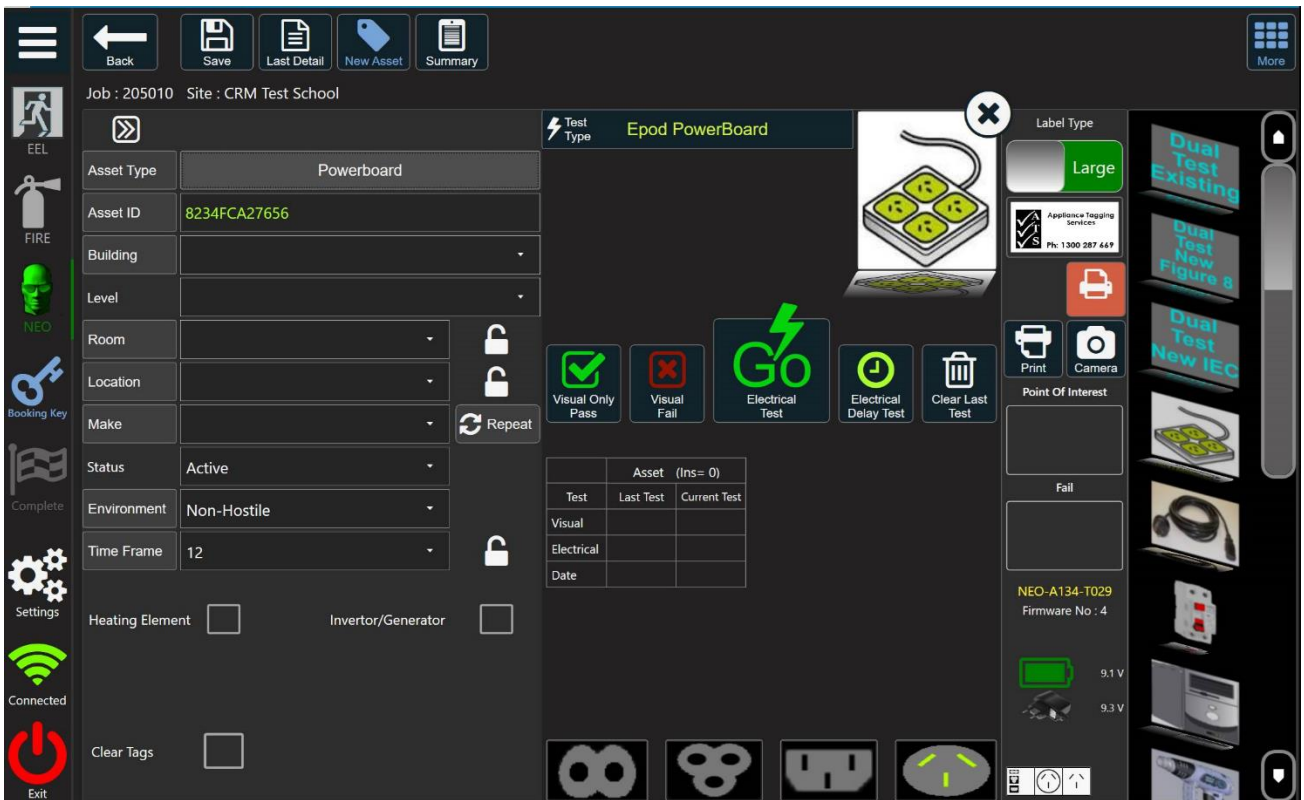

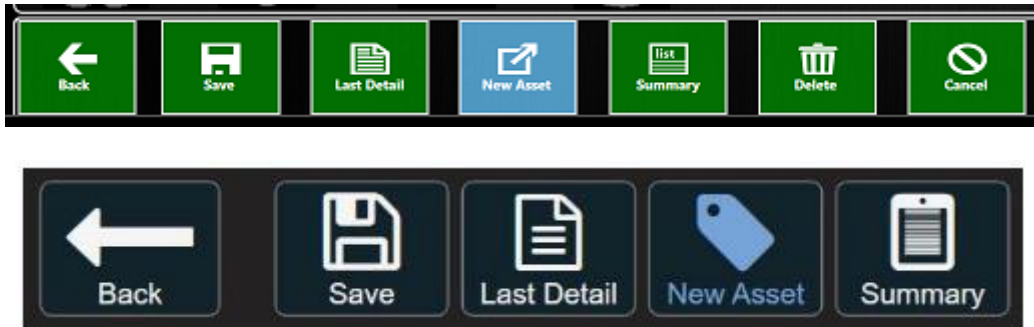

- 7 'Go' button

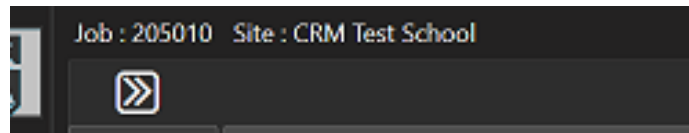
1 Row of buttons

Moved from the bottom of the screen to the top.



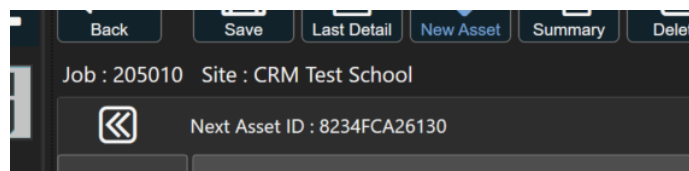
2 Next Asset Id

Down arrow replaced by a double arrow icon in the top left corner.



Click on the arrow to expand.

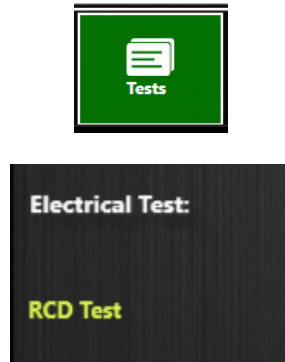
Now called 'Next Asset ID'.



3 Test Type

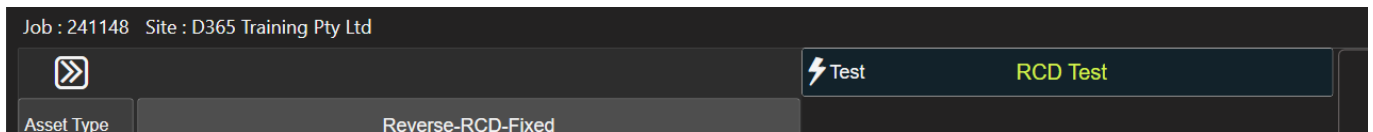
'Tests' button moved from the bottom of the screen.

Test type display moved from the middle of the screen.

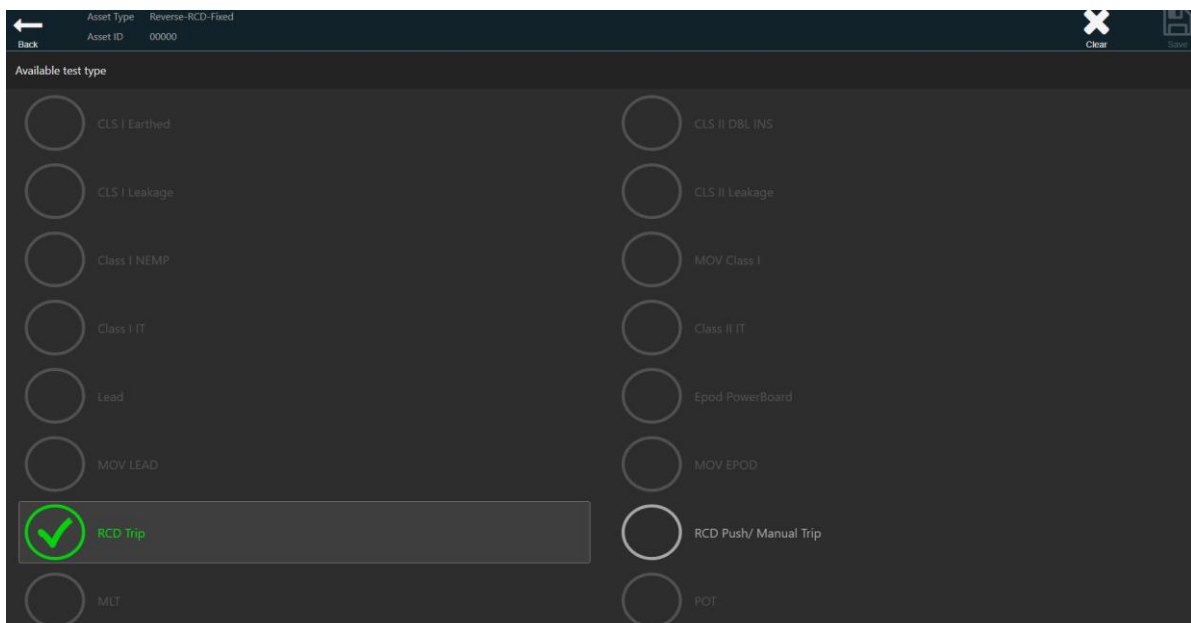


Both now at the top of the screen.

Click in the 'Text' box to change the test type.

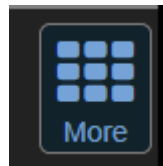


Test Type screen has also been updated:

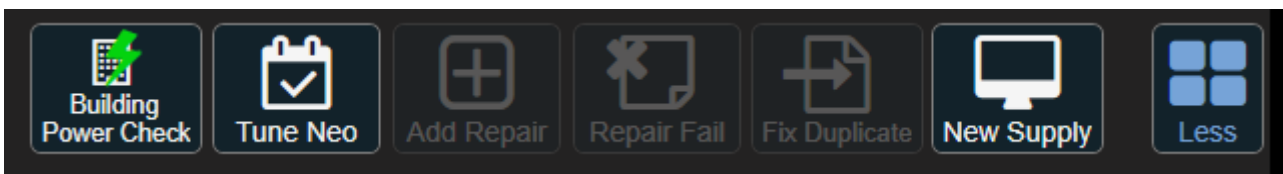


4 'More' button

Moved from the bottom row of buttons to the top right corner.



Click to expand:



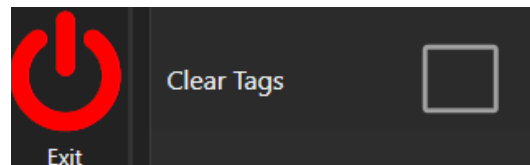
5 EPOD type

Moved from the bottom left of the screen to the right-hand side.



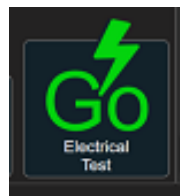
6 Clear Tags

Moved from the middle of the screen to the bottom left corner.



7 'Go' button

Moved from the middle of the screen to the bottom right.



Delete Asset Button

The functionality to delete the current assets has been moved to the asset image to bring the look and feel up to date with app standards.

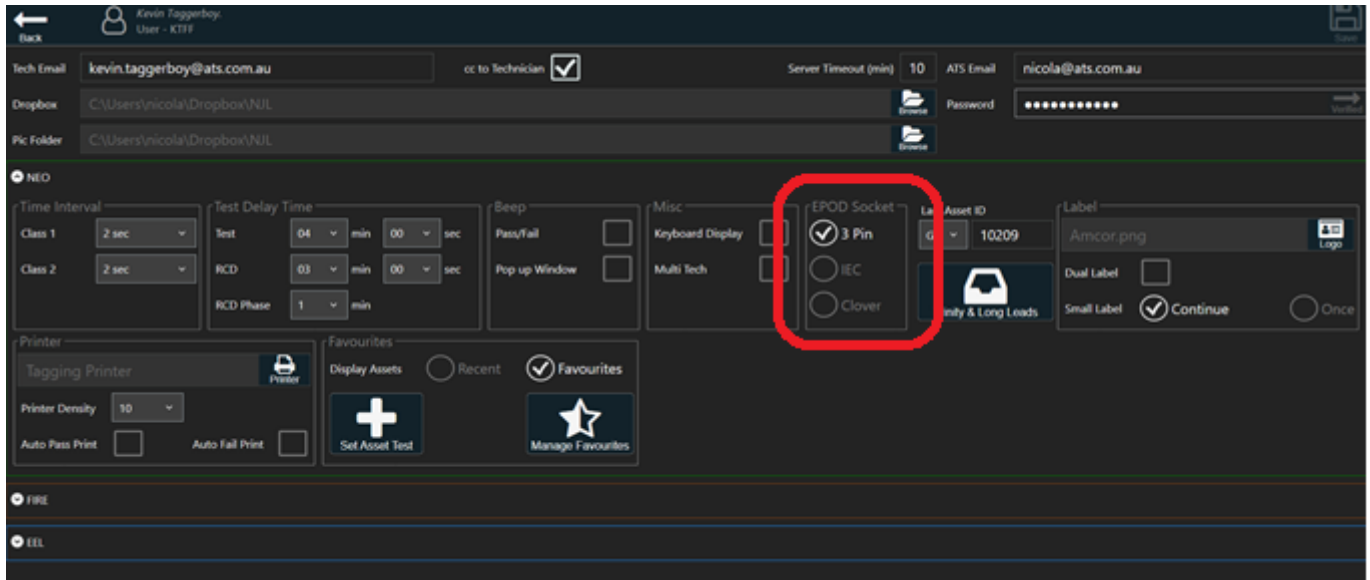


Is now represented by a cross on the corner of the asset image.



Default EPOD Socket Settings

It is possible to set a default EPOD socket type in Settings.

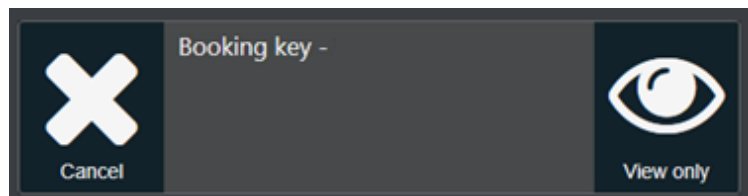


Booking Key

When opening a job in AIRS, a Booking Key is now required.

This is generated in the booking in Field Service once the safety checklist has been completed.

Refer to the 'M365 Field Service Changes 2020_03' document for more details.



Enter the Booking Key into AIRS and continue testing as normal.

Once entered in one of the AIRS apps, it can be opened in any of the apps on that day.

A Booking Key is required **per booking per day**.

View Mode

It is only possible to get the booking code on the day of the booking.

Therefore to see the details of an upcoming job in AIRS before the day, use the 'View only' option.

This has limited functionality and lots of buttons are disabled.
